



Compliance Documentation for Basis Products

To whom it may concern,

This letter confirms the electrical safety compliance status of the Basis Smart Panel and its associated Circuit Module.

The Basis Smart Panel does not appear on the list of medium-risk electrical equipment as defined by WorkSafe New Zealand. Accordingly, it is not required to have a Supplier Declaration of Conformity (SDoC) under the Electrical (Safety) Regulations.

However, Basis is still required to ensure the Smart Panel is electrically safe. To meet this obligation, Basis holds an IANZ-endorsed test report demonstrating compliance with AS/NZS 61439.1 and AS/NZS 61439.3. This test report has been used to support the registration of the Smart Panel as a Level 1 product on the Electrical Equipment Safety System (EESS) database.

The Circuit Module used within the Smart Panel is classified as a high-risk article and is therefore required to be certified. This certification has been completed through a recognised third-party certifier, and the module is also registered on the EESS database.

Both the Smart Panel and the Circuit Module are marked with the Regulatory Compliance Mark (RCM), declaring compliance with all relevant Australian and New Zealand electrical safety regulations. WorkSafe accepts EESS registration as evidence of compliance, provided that New Zealand requirements are covered, which our registrations do.
